Family discussion questions

1. How do you feel about storms? Do they scare you?
 2. Parents— tell your kiddos about a storm that you remember as a child. If you were scared what did you do?
 3. What person in your life do you always feel safe with when they are around?
 4. Why does this person make you feel safe?
- We feel safe with these people because we know that they love us and will protect us!
 - God loves us and wants to protect us too!

So what does this mean for us?

- We can feel that safe knowing that God is there protecting us too! We may not see Him like we see each other but our verse today says He has overcome the world. This means that anything we face in our life (especially if we're afraid!) that God is bigger and more powerful than that thing and can keep us safe and secure.
- A verse from last week was **Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever.** The same Jesus that pulled Peter up from the water is the same Jesus that's by your side today!

"God thank you so much that you are always here to keep us safe. Please help us to keep our eyes on you everyday and to trust you even when we feel afraid. We love you God. In Jesus name, Amen."

Family Activities

1. Object lesson: Jesus calms the storm
 - Materials: vinegar, baking soda, and cooking oil
 - A. Fill one glass up 2/3 up with vinegar (can use blue food coloring if you want!)
 - B. Pour in one spoon full of baking soda to create the storm!
 - C. Pour the cooking oil over the fizz to calm the storm
2. Game: Sink or Float
 - Fill up the sink or bath tub with water
 - Everyone collect objects from around the house and guess whether each one will sink or float!
3. Fun snack
 - Make blue jello
 - Once the jello is solidified, top it off with your choice of Peter walking on water! (gummy bears, sour patches, etc)
